This is for information of all concerned that, as per the notification issued by the Director of Higher Education, Assam vide Ecf No: 530606/1 Dated 31/07/2024, regarding admission in FYUG 1st Semester, for the academic session 2024-25 under CUET category, the candidates willing to take admission in this college are to follow the following points:

1. Admission for FYUGP (Four Year Undergraduate Programme) under CUET mode will be provisioned only through the common admission portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>).
2. Students will get six options for program selection either in the same Higher Educational Institution (University/Colleges) or in different Higher Educational Institutions (HEI) (University/Colleges). Six options may be exercised by the applicant in the Non-CUET category separately. In case, an applicant exhausts all six options, they may discard their application and apply afresh within the correction window, as mentioned above. Six option limits is applicable only for the Non-CUET admissions. Exhausting the six option limit in Non-CUET shall not block the applicants to apply in CUET based admission process. However, for CUET category, the options will be as per the CUET norms.
3. Students need to mark preferences against the options of programs. The College shall prepare their Merit list in accordance to the relevant policy of Assam University, Silchar. Universities/Colleges may prepare the merit-list, as per their admission policy and criteria, either based on marks or preference. It is not mandatory for the HEIs to prepare the Merit list on the basis of preference only.
4. The HEIs will mark the students considered for offering admission by processing the merit list in the admission portal itself. Once marked and saved by the College, the merit list for the programs will be auto-generated and visible to students in the "merit list section" of the admission portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>)
5. The students will receive an admission offer message with a URL in their registered e-mail and mobile number for further processing. Only upon acceptance of the admission offer by the applicant by logging into their admission portal, the Universities or Colleges will be able to process the application for grant of admission.
6. The College will have the discretion to check and verify the Income certificates produced by applicants at the time of admission. In case of any doubt, the Institution may ask the candidate to produce further relevant documents to ascertain the validity of the claim regarding the status of income below 2 lakhs, and only after being fully satisfied with the authenticity of the claim they will be granted admission under the Fee Waiver category. If the Institution is unsatisfied with the claim, they need to inform the applicant in writing with justification and grant admission under the non-fee waiver category.
7. In case, the Ration Card is given as an income document, HEIs are to verify the income, which will be shown in the admission portal through API from the NFSA database at the time of grant of admission, and if satisfied that the income is below 2 lakhs then Fee waiver is to be granted.

- The candidates selected in the 1st merit list under CUET will come to college for admission on 12th & 13th AUG , 2024,
- The candidates selected in the 2nd merit list under CUET will come to college for admission on 16th, 17th & 18th AUG, 2024
- The candidates for **Spot Admission** will come to college for admission **from 19th AUG to 20th AUG, 2024.** (ONLY UNDER CUET)

(For regulations related to Spot Admission a separate notification will be issued)
