
1. World Environment Day (5th June, 2018) [No. of Participants: 30]


1. One Week Awareness Drive on Anti-Plastic Campaign (12th to 18th September, 2019) [No. of Participants: 75]

2. Door-to-Door Awareness Program on Covid-19 (16th to 31st March, 2020) [No. of Participants: 20]



2. Library Literacy Programme:




