There is a need to review the CBCS syllabus. Strengthening ICT-based facilities for students. Lack of mechanism to assess and review the performances of teachers internally. 	of the suggestions given by the teachers and decided that curriculum and syllabi related issues be put up in the next BUGS and Academic Council Meetings of Assam University, Silchar (AUS), as many of the faculty members of the college are also members of different BUGS committees and Academic Council of AUS. Regarding strengthening of ICT facilities for students, the IQAC took initiative to approach the authority for purchasing more computers for the computer centre. As teachers' performances are assessed and reviewed through CAS promotion, the IQAC did not take any additional initiative for the same. However, the IQAC requested all faculty members to periodically submit their academic and research details to IQAC for record.
