

NOTIFICATION OF STUDENTS' UNION **ELECTION OF RADHAMADHAB COLLEGE,** **SILCHAR-788006**

With a view to developing a healthy corporate life and to promote social, cultural and moral activity, the concerned authority of Radhamadhab College is pleased to issue the following notification for the execution of Students Union Election in Radhamadhab College for the session 2026-2027

As per the Constitution of the Students' Council, the election shall be held for the following posts of the office bearers.

1. Vice President (From 5th Semester)
2. General Secretary (From 3rd Semester)
3. Secretary, Sports (From 1st Semester)
4. Secretary, Music and Drama / Cultural Secretary (Open to all classes)
5. Secretary, Boys Common Room (From 1st Semester)
6. Secretary, Girls Common Room (From 1st Semester)
7. Editor, College Magazine (Open to all classes)
8. Secretary, Debate (Open to all classes)
9. Secretary, Book Bank (Open to all classes)
10. Secretary, Social Service (Open to all classes)

QUALIFICATION OF A CANDIDATE

1. He / She must be a regular student of the College
2. He / She must not have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
3. He / She shall have to attain the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the university (75% attendance)
4. He / She must bear a good conduct.



ELECTION SCHEDULE

- Collection of Nomination Papers: From **27th August, 2026 (Thursday) to 28th August, 2026 (Friday)**. (Nomination Papers will be available in the Department of Economics and the Department of Education). **Time (From 11.00 A.M. to 3.00 P.M)**
- Submission of Nomination Papers: **28th August, 2026 (Friday)**. (Nomination Papers should be submitted to the Returning Officer(s) namely, (1) Dr. Nabanita Debnath and (2) Dr. Santosh Borah in the Principal's Chamber). **Time (From 11.00 A.M to 4.00 P.M)**
- Scrutiny of Nomination Paper is on **29th August, 2026 (Saturday)**.
- The last date of withdrawal of Nomination: **29th August, 2026 (Saturday)**. **(Time: Upto 2.00 P.M)**
- Final list of contesting candidates will be published: **29th August, 2026 (Saturday) at 4.00 P.M**
- Candidates can campaign for their respective posts from **30th August, 2026 (Sunday) to 01st September, 2026 (Tuesday) upto 4.00 P.M**. No campaigning is allowed on **2nd & 3rd September, 2026 (Wednesday & Thursday respectively)**.
- Election will be conducted on **3rd September, 2026, (Thursday) from 10.00 A.M to 1.00 P.M**. Counting for election will start from **2.30 P.M** and result will be announced on the same day.
- **Willing student must submit his / her nomination as 'Independent Candidate' and not on Political Party / Organizational basis in order to prevent the entry of politics. Revealing his / her affiliation to any party / organization shall render him / her disqualified for election.**
- Student(s) willing to contest the election is eligible to file nomination for a **single post only**.

*** *Minor changes in the election schedule may be effected by the Principal / Chief Election Officer if the situation calls for.*



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CANDIDATES

A Candidate contesting election must have to obey the following code(s) of conduct:

- (i) No candidate shall indulge in any activity which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension among different castes, communities and religious or linguistic group(s) or between any group(s) of the student.
- (ii) Criticism of the candidates when made shall be confined to their policies and programme, past record and work. It should not be related with any aspects of private life not connected with the public activities.
- (iii) There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes.
- (iv) No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, pamphlets for canvassing, to carry out processions or public meetings inside and outside the college campus and to use loud speakers, vehicles for the purpose of election. But platform lectures in the classrooms are allowed subject to written permission from the Principal i/c.
- (v) Candidate shall co-operate with the officers on election duty to ensure peaceful and orderly polling and complete freedom to the voters to exercise their franchise without being subjected to any annoyance or obstruction.
- (vi) The candidate without a valid pass from the authority cannot enter the polling booths. But at the time of casting his / her vote, he / she can enter the polling booth producing his / her Identity and Fee Card.
- (vii) Procession or celebration of winning election by any candidate inside and outside the college is strictly prohibited.
- (viii) Any contravention of any code of conduct may make the candidate liable to be stripped of his / her candidature or his / her elected post as the case may be. Moreover, the College Authority may take disciplinary action against such a violator.



- (ix) The candidate(s) can lodge complaints regarding election in the next day of the announcement of the results. The complainant will lodge the complaint to Dr. Kalipada Das, Convenor, Grievance Redressal Cell by paying Rs.500/-. The fee will be forfeited if the complaint does not stand. However, if the complaint is proved with evidence the money will be refundable.
- (x) The winning candidate(s) will be administered oath of office within 10 days of the announcement of the result and the date and time for the same will be notified by the Principal i/c of the College.
- (xi) The Electoral Roll of the Students of the College will be published on **25th August, 2026 (Tuesday)**. Any student having any issue regarding the said electoral roll should meet Dr. Arunabha Bhattacharjee, Chief Election Officer between **25th August, 2026 (Tuesday) to 27th August, 2026 (Thursday)**.

FEES AND SECURITY OF MONEY OF NOMINATION

- a. **Cost of Nomination Papers:** A fee of Rs.50/- (Rupees Fifty only) is to be paid by a student / candidate who collects Nomination Papers.
- b. **Nomination Fees:** A fee of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) is to be paid by a candidate who submits nomination. **Nomination Fee is non-refundable.**
- c. **Security Money:** A Security Money of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) is to be paid by all candidates who submit nomination. The Security Money in full is refundable to the winning candidates and to the candidates securing at least $\frac{1}{4}$ th of the total votes polled for that post. The Security Money is also refundable to the candidates withdrawing his / her nomination within the stipulated time. However, the Security Money is non-refundable to the losing candidate(s) securing less than $\frac{1}{4}$ th of the total votes polled for that particular post.
