The willing candidates can submit their application along with requisite documents like scanned copy of H.S & H.S.L.C Marksheet, Registration Card, Photograph of (i) Candidate (ii) Guardian, Scanned copy of Signature of Student, Bank A/C number, Bank Name & address details with IFSC Code, Gap certificate in case of students having a gap of maximum 2 years etc. through <a href="www.rmcadmission.com">www.rmcadmission.com</a> from 10-07-2022 to 16-07-2022. The selection list will be published on 19-07-2022.

It is to be noted that, all candidates must have own email ID & mobile number. The submission process for T.D.C Arts & Commerce 1st semester will be done on OTP basis of given mobile number.

Further, the candidates seeking admission in T.D.C (Arts) 1st semester Pass course, must have minimum of 50% cut-off marks in aggregate in H.S examination of AHSEC or (10+2 standard) equivalent board/council recognized by the Assam University, Silchar. This rule will not be applicable for Radhamadhab College H.S final year passed out students and all candidates for seeking admission in commerce T.D.C Pass course. Further, Manipuri AECC opted candidates for Pass course also can apply without cut-off marks.

In case of submission of Honours admission in T.D.C (Arts) 1st semester including Radhamadhab College H.S final year passed out students must have minimum of 55% cut-off marks in aggregate in H.S examination of AHSEC or (10+2 standard) equivalent board/council recognized by the Assam University, Silchar. Those who want to apply for Commerce Honours must have minimum of 50% cut-off marks in aggregate in H.S examination of AHSEC or (10+2 standard) equivalent board/council recognized by the Assam University, Silchar.

However, as per government reservation policy, maximum of 5% relaxation will be given to SC, ST, OBC, MOBC, EWS on submission of valid scanned copy of caste certificate as per norms.

The admission process will be strictly based of the merit basis.
